

- 4. On Saturday, November 17 go to www.dlms.ca and with your username and password log in to the DLMS website. After the sale broadcast has started click the VIEW SALE button on the home page for the sale you are interested in bidding on. (DLMS starts purebred sale broadcasts approximately 30 min prior to sale time and the VIEW SALE button will appear at this point when the sale broadcast is started.)
