After a very successful year selling Atomics rookie bull calf crop, we bring several of those high selling bulls sisters to The Evolution, and they are as good as we have ever offered. Highlighted by our lot 1 female; a daughter of our favorite, Virginia Kollete 240K. As always, we have a group of Battle Cry daughters that are consistent in colour and maternal qualities. We lost Battle Cry this past spring so his daughters will be kept pretty close to our herd moving forward. Several of these females carry a service to our new calving ease bull, Anchor D Macs Maximus 438M who is a dark red Virginia Bowman son that we are quite excited about.

On the red side, we are excited to feature some Tangleflags progeny for the first time. Our leadoff red bred is as good as we have ever offered, and stems from the powerful Cream Soda cow family.

Most of the service sires include Wepplers Eight Ball 168M and RWR Roller 75M, who have both passed expectations here.

On the black side, it's about as consistent a group from top to bottom as we have. Several LFE Cabaret 847J daughters sell, with most females going back to some of our top donors. Every black heifer carries a valuable service to the calving ease favorite of many, Ultra Tokyo Rose 17M.

The Simmental heifer calf offering is the largest it's ever been, with a majority of the calves being backed by some of our best donors. Daughters of proven cows and also daughters available off some new and exciting donors like Summer 33H, Fancy Pants 21F, Sammie 185L, and more.

The Angus division is as big and strong as ever, with a large portion being the result of embryo work. We feel we have something to suit everyone's taste, with a diversified set of genetics that still find consistency in type and quality. We believe 205N checks as many boxes as any fullblood female we have offered. Her dam is arguably our number one fullblood donor, and knocked it out of the park with this group of ET siblings. We sold two full brothers to 205N this past spring, where they averaged \$95 000 selling to Rafter 4T Farms and Stanley Martins/River Bend Cattle. 205N carries her dams same blood red colour with lots of pigment, powerful rib and body shape, and length of spine. She is attractive up front, looks to be extremely ideal in her foot size and shape, and teat and udder design. Her early service to the proven Battle Cry should be nothing short of exciting and dependable. We look forward to building around 240K for years to come, and feel that 205N could follow in her dams footsteps.

334N is the youngest female in the bred heifer division but has had no problem keeping up. She's a smooth polled Atomic daughter that is attractive, deep ribbed, and sound structured. 235H and her dam 96D were very alike, and quite ideal in our mind. Medium framed cows with very good udders, lots of rib shape, and maintained body condition year round. We are excited about Atomics first calf crop and excited to get his daughters in production. This past spring, we sold our first Atomic sons where 23 head averaged just shy of \$25 000.



Non-Diluter. Another favorite in the offering and a female with lots of cow power stacked behind her. Zaviera 211K is currently our highest selling fullblood female to date, going to our good friend Elliott Lindgren. Similar to 240K, we were eager to flush her to the new and exciting Atomic and are very impressed with the results. We sold three powerhouse full brothers to 234N this past spring who were all great coloured, big nuted, and the performance driven kind. 234N is extremely soft made and flexible on the move, and looks to be setting down an awesome udder. Her granddam 23Z produced here until she was 14, and was still an impressive, powerful cow with a great foot right until the end. The calf 234N is carrying has a good chance of being homozygous polled, and could be the ticket to a quick ROI.

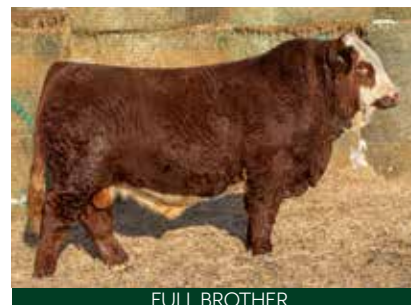

Lot 6 & 7. Non-Diluters. We have said it quite a bit for the last little while that we want to build around who we feel are our top three fullblood cows currently. Those females would include 240K (dam of lot 1), 211K (dam of lot 5), and 41H (dam of lots 6 & 7). 41H has been a no miss cow for us and our partner Elliott, and consistently produces quality offspring no matter the mating. To date we have sold 13 offspring off 41H and she is nearing \$400 000 in direct progeny sales, with one son being used in our own program. The white faced 39N is powerful all the way through with a wide pin set, lots of topside muscle shape, and overall body mass. 67N offers more pigment, deep lower body, and a smooth made image. 41H and Atomic progeny alike are often very big and square footed, and these two sisters carry that trait, while having advantages in terms of udder quality as well. We are committed to offering our best and that's why we offer up females from our top cow families, like these two sisters.

Non-Diluter. Sticking with the theme of consistent cow families with longevity on their side, 100N is a smooth made, long spined female with extra dark red pigment. Her granddam Ms Xiang 14X was an old donor cow for us that produced well whether they were bulls or females. We have used one of her sons in our own program through AI, one grandson retained and walked here, and have several daughters in production. 241L is sired by the great female maker French Attack, and is exactly what we hoped for when we flushed 14X that way. With the addition of Battle Cry in 100N's pedigree, I would expect her maternal strengths to show for years to come.

Diluter. A polled female that is a little on the younger side but offers an attractive, well balanced image. 947Z is a huge bodied female who gave birth to 322N at the age of 13. She's a daughter of the famed Kananaskis donor owned by Ferme Gagnon, and stems from one of the most elite cow families in the breed.
